Pulcinella and other marvellous stories (6x9’)

Come and discover the magical world of Gianini and Luzzati!

The series, just restored, is made up of six episodes that take children on a journey into a world of colours where magical fairytales go hand in hand with exciting adventures. Magical fishes, golden balls and firebirds are among the favourite characters in these tales that never grow old. This series aims to highlight these two authors’ incredible talent for sparking the imaginations of our younger viewers. And what better ambassador could there be for this task than the iconic character of Pulcinella?



Peo Gallery (39x3’) No dialogs

With Peo, the cheerful blue dog, we get into the world of the most important painters. This picture gallery presents a wide variety of topics: landscapes, still lifes, portraits, indoor scenes, celebrations... as well as different moods expressed on canvass. Surprisingly different styles will be explored by Peo: from Van Gogh’s volumes and colours, to the secrets of Magritte, Dalì and De Chirico; from Gauguin’s tropical colours to the musicality of Chagall and Klee...



Ta-pit (80x2’) No dialogs

The adventures of amusing and playful characters, made of pieces of cork, bottle stoppers, paper, buttons, pins, feathers...



The house of science (22x5’) ITA/FRE

22 episodes to give answers to the most important natural phenomena with an amusing and smart approach. (for kids from 10 years old).



Animalopus (20x2’) ITA/FRE

Little Emma and Luca really love animals and they have great fun playing a very special game: they associate every animal with a job. One of those typical jobs that kids inevitably choose when they announce “When I grow up, I’m going to be a ...”. So, the kids imagine the animals doing such jobs as a firefighter, doctor or airline pilot. They are perfectly at ease doing this... until the situation gets out of hand. At that point, the kids have to take control. Perhaps it’s better that someone else does these jobs!



TV Bio (16x5’)

The biodiversity told in a TV program. As it is in the news. Packaged and introduced by children in elementary school who become protagonists and spokesmen of the respect for the environment. Everyone can make the difference.
